Paper Collars for Stray Cats

INSTRUCTIONS

1. If the cat is noticeably thin, unhealthy, or in weather related distress, please contact Regina Humane Society Animal Protection Services at (306) 777-7700.
2. Print out this template on standard office copy paper (don't use thick paper).
3. Write your contact telephone number in the space provided and cut out one collar.
4. If you can safely approach and touch the cat, wrap the paper collar around the cat's neck. Ensure the fitted collar allows for two fingers to be placed between the collar and the cat's neck.
5. Use a small piece of scotch tape to close the collar.
6. If you get no response from the owner, please contact the Regina Humane Society's Lost & Found department at (306) 543-6363, ext. 237 to discuss solutions.
