



PET EMERGENCY Checklist

It's always important to be ready for an emergency situation, this includes making sure you have pet supplies for 2-4 weeks.

FOOD, WATER AND TREATS (for 2-4 weeks)

Dogs: 4 litres of water/day. Cats: 1 litre water/day.
Food and water dishes.

RELIABLE KENNEL OR CRATE FOR EACH PET

TOWELS AND BLANKETS

WASTE SUPPLIES

Waste bags for dogs. Cat litter box, litter, scoop, garbage bags for cats. Extra bedding, water bottle, hiding box, and hay for small critters.

TOYS

Kongs, balls, feather wands, food or treat dispensing puzzles and toys are all great choices to help keep pets entertained and lower stress.

MEDICATIONS AND MEDICAL RECORDS

Medication for 2-4 weeks, veterinarian contact information, vaccination records, along with photos and written descriptions of your pets. Store these items in a water proof bag.

RECORD MICROCHIP, TATTOO AND PET LICENSE

Keep this information with their medical information. Make sure all your contact information is up-to-date with the microchip company.

COLLAR WITH TAGS

Make sure tags have up-to-date owner information.

OTHER SUPPLIES

Dog leashes (6 foot and 15-20 foot), harness, and muzzle. Cat harness and leash. Disinfectant for pet mess clean-up and paper towels.

PET FIRST AID KIT

Pet First Aid guide book

Exam gloves

Small flashlight

Blunt tip scissors

Gauze pads and rolls

Rubbing alcohol

Antibiotic ointment

Sterile rinse solution

Cold pack

Bandage materials

Thermometer and lubricating jelly
