Mesh Tube Toy


SAFETY REMINDER: Remember to always supervise pets while playing with enrichment toys.





You will need:

- Three pieces of mesh tubing
- A pair of scissors



STEP TWO



Tie all three pieces of mesh tubing into a knot in the centre.

Pipe Cleaner Toy


SAFETY REMINDER: Remember to always supervise pets while playing with enrichment toys.



STEP ONE

You will need:

- One pipe cleaner
- One bottle cap



STEP TWO

STEP THREE

Tie a knot at each end near the bottle cap. Be sure the bottle cap can not come off. Double knot if needed.

Using a pen, pencil, or even your finger, wrap the long end of the pipe cleaner around to achieve a curl. **STEP FOUR**

Catnip Sock

STEP ONE

You will need:

- One sock
- A handful of newspaper or toilet paper
- A pinch of catnip



Stuff the sock with the newspaper or toilet paper.

STEP TWO


STEP THREE

Put a pinch of catnip in the sock
* You don't need much!



Tie the end of the sock closed.

STEP TOUR



Catnip famously makes cats feel euphoric! However, it only affects 70% of cats!

Surprise Box

SAFETY REMINDER: Remember to always supervise pets while playing with enrichment toys.



STEP ONE

You will need:

- One empty toilet paper roll
- Small handful of cat treats
- A pair of scissors



Fold one end of the toilet paper roll in.

STEP TWO



Fill the roll with cat treats.



Fold the remaining open end closed.

STEP FOUR



Cats need to use their brains to get the treats out!
