

Bottle Sock

SAFETY REMINDER: Remember to always supervise pets while playing with enrichment toys.



STEP ONE

You will need:

- One 591 mL bottle
- One long sock



Push the bottle inside the sock, squishing it afterwards.

STEP TWO

STEP THREE

Tie a knot in the open end of the sock to enclose the bottle inside.

Dogs love how the bottles crackle!



Sock Ball Toy

SAFETY REMINDER: Remember to always supervise pets while playing with enrichment toys.



STEP ONE

You will need:

- One sock
- One tennis ball
- A pair of scissors



Wiggle the ball down to the toe of the sock.

STEP TWO

STEP THREE

Tie a knot in the sock closer to the ball so the ball cannot fall out.



Cut bigger strips along the opening of the sock.

Towel Rope

SAFETY REMINDER: Remember to always supervise pets while playing with enrichment toys.



STEP ONE

You will need:

- One towel
- A pair of scissors



Lay the towel down on a hard flat surface. Using the scissors cut three strips that are 2-3 inches wide.

STEP TWO

STEP THREE

Ensure the strips are equal length. Knot the strips together at one end, leaving a long tail.



Starting at the base of the knot, braid the strips until you reach the end. If the towel is longer tie a knot once or twice in the middle. Knot the end.

STEP FOUR

Dogs love to give these towel ropes a good shake!
