- 18 inch elastic cord
- Two plastic bottle caps
- One jingle ball
- Scissors

Step One

Tie a loop around one end of the elastic cord.

Step Two

Use scissors to poke a small hole in the center of each plastic bottle cap.

Remember: Scissors are sharp – don't be afraid to ask for help!

Step Three

Thread the elastic cord through both plastic bottle caps. Knot one cap below the loop and the second cap staggered below. Finally, tie the jingle ball at the end of the cord.


Remember: Trim any frayed cord to protect your pet from choking.

- One craft feather

Step One

Using the poker tool, make a small hole at the top of the bottle cork.

Step Two

Warm-up the hot glue gun. When it's ready, place a small dot of glue on the hole at the top of the bottle cork.

Remember: Hot glue guns are hot - don't be afraid to ask for help!


Step Three

Before the glue dries, push the quill of the craft feather into the hole. Wait 15 minutes for the glue to cool before using.

- Three empty toilet paper rolls
- One empty cereal box


- Hot glue gun

Step One

Unfold the empty cereal box and lay it flat. Using the scissors, cut the three empty toilet paper rolls in half. Next, cut the empty egg carton to separate each egg holder.

Step Two

Warm-up the hot glue gun. While waiting, on top of the flattened cereal box, plan a unique design using the rolls and egg holders to hide small cat treats.

Place thin lines of glue to secure pieces of your design together. Wait 15 minutes for the glue to cool before placing the treats in their hiding spots!

Using scissors, cut out three small holes or geometric shapes on the outside of the empty paper towel roll.

Fold in one end of the roll to close the roll. Through the opposite open end, fill the roll with a few small cat treats.

Step Three

Fold in the remaining open end of the roll to hold the treats inside.

Now it's time to let your cat play, and enjoy the treats as they fall out through the holes!



- One sock
